

Claim Photograph Instructions

To expedite your advance claim payment photographs are required. Photographs of the insured property will help document and assist in consideration of an advanced or full payment.

To best assist the adjuster we ask that you take photographs of several areas around the insured property. The required locations are as follows:

1. Front of the Property
2. Right Side of the Property
3. Back of the Property
4. Left Side of the Property
5. Exterior Watermark of the Property
6. Interior Watermark of the Property

Here are some tips for photographing these areas.


For the first four photos (Front, Right Side, Back, and Left Side of the property) we would like clear views of the insured property. These should be unobstructed by landscaping. If there are vents, the photos should show them.

For the Exterior and Interior Watermarks of the property, we would like the photos to show the watermark along with the watermark's height. Please use a measuring device (e.g. tape measure, yardstick, etc.) and include that in the photo by pointing to, or indicating in some way, the height of the watermark. Be sure to place the measuring device squarely on the ground and measure vertically up to the watermark line.

The photos of damaged property should clearly show the direct physical damage to the insured property. If you carry Coverage B – Personal Property coverage, please document the damaged items and locations with photos.


When submitting the photographs please also include a short description of each photo (e.g. "Living Room Wall, Watermark 45 inches"; "Right Side").
